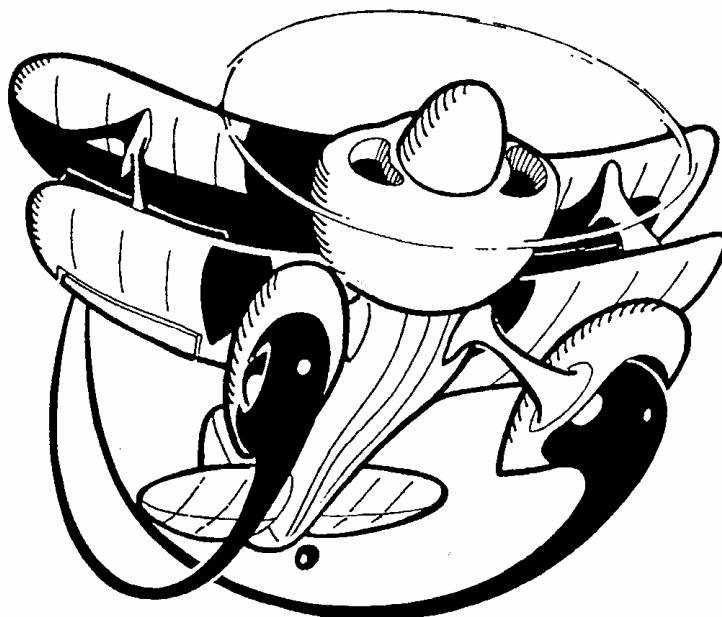

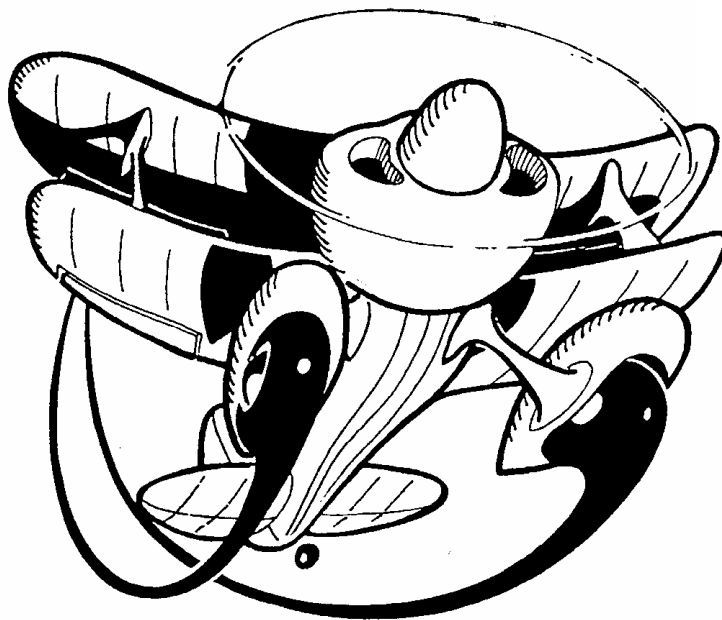
There is a \$4.00 entry fee for the first class and \$2.00 for the second.
