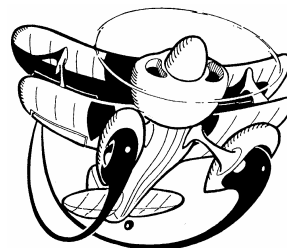

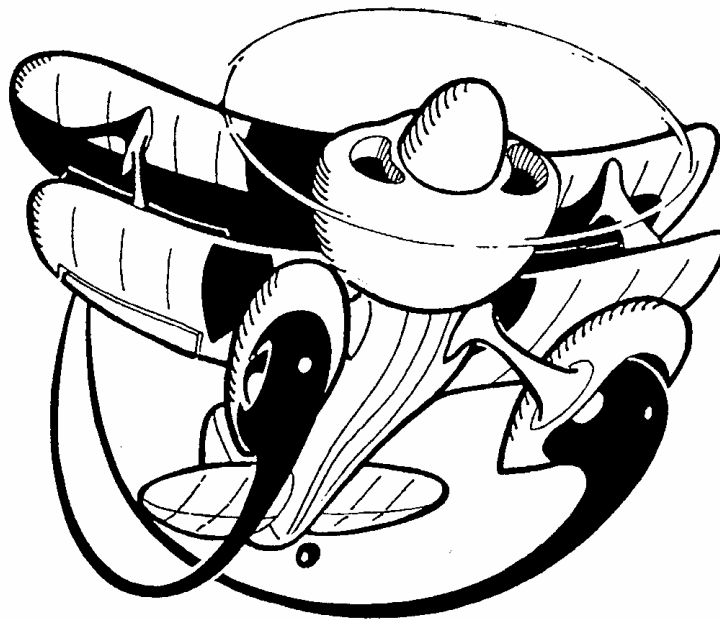
Fun Fly

Novice: Indian guide, Bomb drop, Loops for 1 min

Sportsman: 3 t&g in a circle, Spin cycle*, 7-11

Advanced Sportsman: Twister, Dice Roops, Matador**

Expert: Scrouge*, Twister**, Spin cycle***

***(Spin cycle) Complete as many spins as you can in 90 seconds!! But**

note you must hang your hat on the pole (running required) to stop the clock.. don't go over!!

**** (Twister) Like the game of fame, T&G on the colored spot when called
(timed event)**

***** (Scrouge) A timed flight, 1 ounce of fuel is installed- fly as long
as you can.. Note 10 seconds are awarded for each loop completed!**
