Fun fly report:

~The Fun Fly routine has been redesigned. Highlights include, but are not limited to;

1. There are now 3 classes; novice, nitro, and electric.
2. Each class will have three events with one being a luck event as before.
3. Each contestant will fly the events of a given class twice, with the lowest score being thrown out*.
4. A contestant may fly in up to two classes.
5. The events for nitro, and electric will be the same.
6. Entry fee is \$4 for the 1st class, \$2 for additional class.
7. Year end trophies will only be for first, second, & third places in each class.

*Flying your three events constitutes a "round", it is your lowest set score that will be thrown out not the lowest event.

Volunteer is still needed to bring food for July's fun fly.

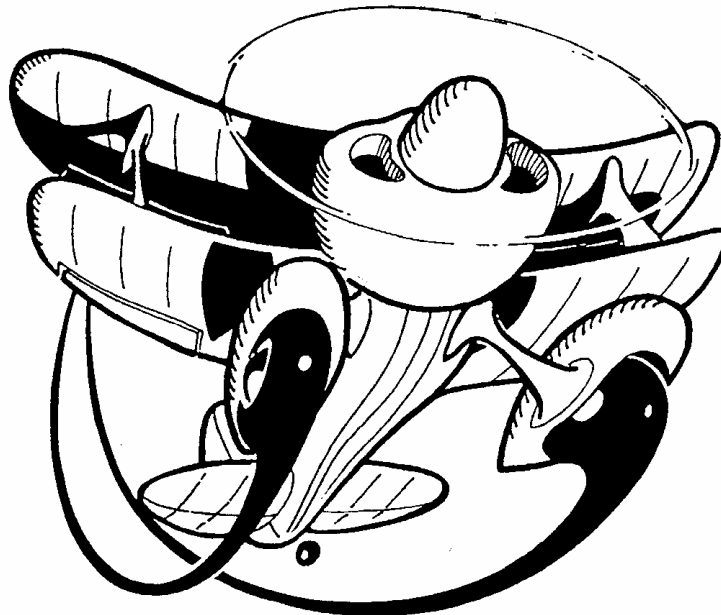
Fun Fly

The events for this FUN FLY will include the following:

NOVICE- 1. Taxi event 2. 3 spins down 3. Dice loops

NITRO/ELECTRIC 1. Twister 2. Balloon Bust 3. Dice Roops

Anyone flying over the pits will receive a "0" for the event. No exceptions

Due to weather conditions some events may change on day of the Fun Fly at CD's discretion.

MORE INFO:

There are also some new rules for the Pylon Racing. Doc Gray is running the Pylon racing this year. Here is the report from him on what is happening with them this year.

There are two classes for pylon:

- 1) The slow pylon -the only engine allowed will be O.S. LA40, the only props allowed will be a) APC 9-6 or, b) the master airscrew 9-6. The engine must be unmodified and the props must be unmodified.
(If you are in need of an La40 and can't find one contact Mike Perkins Doc Gray)**
- 2) The fast pylon -any unmodified 40 size engine costing less than \$200.00. Engine can use an rpm enhancing muffler that bolts to engine. No tuned pipes allowed. Any APC prop can be used.**

Pylon Racing:

Planes must be A.M.A. legal Q-500 types, planes must weigh 3 3/4lbs. Fuel be 15% nitro supplied. Each race is 10 laps. A staggered start will be used this year. The race winner gets 4pts, 2nd place gets 3pts. 3rd place gets 2pts. 4th place gets 1pt. If a racer cuts a pylon score is 1pt. If a racer cuts 2 pylons score is 0pts. If a racer cuts a pylon everyone behind that racer moves up 1pt. (If first place plane gets 1 cut his score is 1pt. The 2nd place plane moves to 1st. place and now gets 4pts. Both the 3rd and 4th place planes move up 1pt.)

5 races for 2008: May, June, July, August, September. At the end of racing in Sept. the three pilots with the highest total points get into the championship race. The remaining pilots have a flyoff for the last open spot in the championship race.

The winner of this race will be the champion. Two plaques will be given; 1) One for the championship, 2) One for high point total for the year.
